## **ITEMS FOR STUDENT BACKPACKS (listed by class)**

### **Applied Science**

- 1 composition book - pages must not rip out. (Students may use same comp books as last year).
- 1 folder to keep handouts. Plastic envelopes with velcro closure preferred.
- Minimum of 3 colored pencils, pens, or markers. Papermate preferred.
- Not required, but helpful. Permanent markers - multiple colored.

### **Core Science**

- 1 wide-ruled composition notebook or SMALL 3-ring binder
- 1 bottle of Elmer's Glue All (please NOT regular white school glue!)

### **Math**

- 1 ruler
- 1 protractor
- 1 compass (preferably this one: <http://www.enasco.com/product/TB18487T>)
- 1 graphing paper spiral notebook (available at Walmart) or graph paper placed in a notebook
- 1- single subject spiral notebook with pocket for handouts
- Algebra students ONLY: Graphing calculator - any TI 84 series

### **Mechanics of Writing**
