## **ITEMS FOR STUDENT BACKPACKS (listed by class)**

### **Language Arts**

- Pencil & Pen & Colored Pen (brought to class every time)
- 1 composition book to be used exclusively for MOW
- 1 spiral notebook
- 1 folder (or section of notebook) for handouts and completed assignments
- 1 3x5 card pack or spiral (This is for At-Home assignments and does NOT need to be brought to class)
- 1 3-ring binder with clear sheet protectors

### **Humanities**

- 1-inch 3-ring binder w/ 8 divider tabs
- 1 pocket folder
- Lined notebook paper
- 1 package colored pencils
- Pencils or Pen (Pen is preferred to pencil, please. Erasable pens are fine.)

### **Engineering Lab** (formerly Applied Science)

- 1 composition book - pages must not rip out.
- 1 folder to keep handouts.
- Minimum of 3 colored pencils, pens, or markers.

### **Core Science**

- 1 set color pencils
- 1 subject poly 3 hole 8 1/2 x 11 notebook - (no comp books) - must be able to attach inside portfolio 3 ring binder. (view example: <https://tinyurl.com/ya5qt9um>)
- 1 - 1.5" to 2" 3 ring binder with clear plastic cover (I have extra if you want to reserve 1 for your student). This is to create student science portfolio for final grade.

### **Math**

- 1 ruler
- 1 protractor

- 1 graphing paper spiral notebook (available at Walmart) or graph paper placed in a notebook
- 2 - single subject spiral notebook with pocket for handouts (one for each semester)
