

A Christmas Carol Stave 5 : The End of It

1. When Scrooge realizes that he's back home and he doesn't even know what day it is, what metaphor does he use about himself? ***He compares himself to a baby***
2. When describing the turkey, Dickens says that he never could have stood upon his legs because they would have snapped. What does he mean by this? ***It's a really fat turkey***
3. Why was Scrooge shaking so much? ***He was so excited, and filled with so much joy for being given another chance***
4. What does Scrooge mean when he tells the man that the money includes "a great many back payments" (118)? ***He hasn't donated in the past, so he is donating even more now to make up for it***

Contrast the reformed Scrooge with the old Scrooge. You must use at least 8 sentences, and they must be well developed (not short, simple sentences.) **25 points**
