1. When Scrooge realizes that he's back home and he doesn't even know what day it is, what metaphor does he use about himself?
2. When describing the turkey, Dickens says that he never could have stood upon his legs because they would have snapped. What does he mean by this?
3. Why was Scrooge shaking so much?
4. What does Scrooge mean when he tells the man that the money includes "a great many back payments" (118)?

Contrast the reformed Scrooge with the old Scrooge. You must use at least 8 sentences, and they must be well developed (not short, simple sentences.) **25 points**
