- Label each prepositional phrase with either ADJ. or ADV.
- Draw arrows from prepositional phrases to the words they modify.

7. Write a friendly note (to the director.)

Handwritten annotations: Write (pron. (You)), friendly (adj.), note (O.P.), (to the director) (prep. ADV.).

8. Carry the books (with both hands.)

Handwritten annotations: Carry (pron. (You)), the (prep.), books (O.P.), (with both hands) (prep. ADV.).

9. Are you happy (about the grade) you received
(in biology?)

Handwritten annotations: Are (pron. (You)), you (pron.), happy (adj.), (about the grade) (prep. ADV.), you (pron.), received (O.P. (that)), (in biology?) (prep. ADV.).

10. Check the mail and pay the bills.

Handwritten annotations: Check (pron. (You)), the (prep.), mail (O.P.), and (conj.), pay (pron. (you)), the (prep.), bills (O.P.).

11. Look (for rare birds) (on the trip) (through the jungle.)

Handwritten annotations: Look (pron. (You)), (for rare birds) (prep. ADV., adj. O.P.), (on the trip) (prep. ADV., O.P.), (through the jungle.) (prep. ADV., O.P.).

12. Don't forget the tape; we'll play it (at the party.)

Handwritten annotations: Don't forget (adv. (You)), the (prep.), tape (O.P.), ; (conj.), we'll (pron.), play (O.P.), it (pron.), (at the party.) (prep. ADV.).
